Popcorn Scarcity

Subject: Social Studies Grade Level: 3-5

Concept: Economic Concepts Method: Experiential Learning

OVERVIEW

This lesson involves teaching the vocabulary term
"scarcity". The teacher brings in brown bags of
popcorn, explaining to students that they will be
enjoying popcorn as we view a powerpoint. Students
will come to the front table one at a time and take as
much popcorn as they wish and place in a paper bag.
The teacher has ensured that there will be a shortage
of popcorn. Explain to students that popcorn is
"scarce". Allow students to brainstorm to solve this
scarcity issue. In the past, students have shared their
popcorn, chosen to equally divide all the popcorn,
and/or elected to make some students go without
popcorn (teacher eventually brings out more for these
students). Discussion of scarce resources world wide
and locally follows this introduction.

Connection to Entrepreneurship: Students experience and understand scarcity. Discussion of scarce resources world wide and locally follows this introduction.
