OVERVIEW

Students will be presented with a community problem that exists within the school setting. They will generate ideas from classroom discussions, local issues, as well as from the students themselves. They will also list possible challenges related to the issues as well as possible solutions to these challenges. Finally, they will create an action plan to address the issue and implement the action plan.

Connection to Entrepreneurship: Students identify a social need and create an innovative solution for that need.
